# Beyond The Circuit: 8 Local Breweries Launch A Limited-Edition Brew for the Singapore Grand Prix



















**SINGAPORE, 08 SEPTEMBER 2025 –** For the first time ever, eight of Singapore's leading independent craft breweries have come together to brew a single beer as part of the Grand Prix Season Singapore (GPSS), the city-wide celebration surrounding the race. The result is **'Beyond the Circuit'**, a limited-edition jasmine-rice tropical lager.



This collaboration brings together LeVeL33, Lion Brewery Co, Little Island Brewing Co, RedDot Brewhouse, Ren Min, SevenDaze Brewery, The 1925 Brewing Co and Brewerkz — with Brewerkz serving as the brewing anchor.

More than just a beer, 'Beyond the Circuit' is a symbol of unity, creativity, and local pride, launched at a time when Singapore's craft scene is stepping onto the global stage. Its name and tagline — **Beyond the Circuit, Above the Ordinary** — reflect exactly where it lives: outside the official race track, brewed for race fans, locals, and visitors looking to experience Singapore's homegrown craft beer scene during GPSS.

"Locked out of the circuit, we decided to take the race to the streets. 'Beyond the Circuit' is our way of celebrating the season with a beer that's brewed the local way — fast, fresh, and full of flavour," said **Mitch Gribov**, **the Head Brewer of Brewerkz**, the project's brewing anchor.

## Beyond Tourism: A Local Craft Showcase

With the Grand Prix drawing visitors from around the world, 'Beyond the Circuit' is brewed for both international audiences and local enthusiasts. For tourists, it offers a distinctive taste of Singapore's craft beer movement; for locals, it's a point of pride and proof of how far the scene has come.

Brewed outside the race track but central to the festivities, the beer celebrates the independent, homegrown community stepping up during Singapore's biggest global moment.

## The Beer: A Jasmine-Rice Tropical Lager

Despite the challenge of aligning eight breweries with unique styles, the collective landed on a recipe that everyone proudly stands behind: a crisp, refreshing lager brewed with jasmine rice for smooth drinkability, layered with tropical hops for an aromatic lift.

The result is a brew that hits the senses with a green-flag burst of passionfruit purée, lime-zest spray, and a pine-forest breeze on the nose, followed by a jasmine-rice crispness that launches juicy citrus flavours into a lightning-dry, podium-clean finish on the palate.

Perfectly suited for Singapore's tropical climate and the energy of race week, the beer is designed to be both approachable and exciting.

"I enjoyed getting together and having a common project the most, regardless of what beer style we choose to brew. It was great to be able to catch up with everyone at once," said **LeVeL33's brewmaster Gabriel Garcia**.

## **Availability and Launch Events**

'Beyond the Circuit' will make its debut on 23 September. Brewerkz One Fullerton & Riverside Point outlets will also carry a beer from each of the seven partner breweries alongside the collaboration brew from 26 September, while stocks last.

Following the launch, each brewery will activate the campaign in their own way — from guest tap takeovers and brewery parties to curated experiences that showcase the beer across Singapore. At LeVeL33, celebrations will include exclusive pours paired with skyline dining and panoramic views of the Marina Bay Street Circuit.

#### Brewerkz

Brewerkz helped kickstart Singapore's craft beer story in 1997. We are a multi-award-winning business and Singapore's longest running craft brewery experience. We are known for our constant flow of tasty experimental beers, inventive cuisine, head-turning collaborations, and championing sustainability. #### • LeVeL33

Founded by Dr. Martin Bém in 2010, LeVeL33 proudly holds the global title of Highest Microbrewery in a Building from GUINNESS WORLD RECORDSTM. #### • The 1925 Brewing Co.
